

- ☀ Travel the main street in a restored 1914 carriage pulled by the two docile Clydesdales, Maggie and Sammy. Join the team at 50 Main St.

- ☀ Taste a range of traditional Hahndorf & Barossa mettwursts — free samples at Taste in Hahndorf, 35 Main St.
- ☀ Pick your own strawberries and check out the range of jams and chutneys made at Beerenberg Strawberry Farm, Mt. Barker Road.

ACTIVITIES FOR CHILDREN

- ☀ Take a magical journey through the 13 village scenes in the fantasy cave of Misty Hollow and meet the animated characters who live at 56 Main St.
- ☀ Watch puppet demonstrations at the Hahndorf Puppet Shop, 29d Main Street
- ☀ Take a train ride around the historic Liebelt Farm, visit the farm animals and browse through the old farm machinery at Platform 1, Junction Rd.
- ☀ Feed the lambs, calves, guinea pigs, rabbits (depending on season), meet ducks, peacocks, wallabies and kangaroos at The Farm Barn, Mt Barker Rd.
