Dr Kevin Cameron

Dr. Kevin Cameron is an Australian music educator and conductor.

He has studied with some of the world's most renowned conducting teachers and has appeared with the Sydney, Tasmanian, West Australian, and Darwin Symphony Orchestras, and many youth and community orchestras and bands throughout Australia.



He was named the inaugural winner of the ABC's Young Conductor of the Year competition and has subsequently held numerous posts in education, including at the University of Newcastle, the Upper Hunter Conservatorium, Pembroke School, and the Melbourne Conservatorium of Music.

Dr Cameron has maintained a passion for music and education and continues to assist the development of musicians through his involvement in professional and community music ensembles as a conductor, coach, adjudicator, advisor, artistic administrator, and teacher.

The Hon David Pisoni MP, State Member for Unley, for kindly printing our programs.


Mitcham City Brass, K&N Brass, Onkaparinga City Concert Band and Unley Concert Band for helping with provision of percussion instruments and equipment.
